1.5 Increase course completer success in core areas for fall term (2% below the National Community College Benchmark): Data Changes in fall, so updated at midyear report.

- College Composition II- from 70.1% to 80.5%
 - Met. FY22 Data: 83.1%.
- College Algebra- from 77.4% to 77.5%
 - Not met. FY22 Data: 63.7%.
 - FA23 schedule will offer triple the number of corequisite sections to work toward improvement on this goal.
- Gateway Math (All Other) from 68.9% to 74.8%
 - Met. FY22 Data: 74.9%.
- Speech from 81.9% to 85.2%
 - Met. FY22 Data: 88.8%.
- Remedial English from 54.0% to 77.7%
 - Not met. FY22 Data: 71.6%.
 - New co-requisite English course will be piloted in FA23 to allow students who place at this level to earn college credit while being supported with just in time assistance.

- First College Math course from 64.3% to 77.0%
 - Not met. FY22 Data: 59.6%.
- Retention (completing course to the end) from 89.0% to 90.6%
 - Not met. FY22 Data: 88.1%.
 - \circ Provided online course quality training to 15 faculty members.
 - Added required one-hour advising planning sessions for all new degree-seeking students.
- Overall passing course among completers from 82.8% to 83.7%
 - Met. FY22 Data: 84.8%.

1.6 Increase Registered Nursing NCLEX pass rate from 82% to 86% (2% below the National Council of State Boards of Nursing).
