Pursuant to Illinois House Bill 3011 (110 ILCS 805/3-7.12), each member of the board of trustees of a community college district shall, before entering upon the duties of the office, take and subscribe to the following oath or affirmation:

"I, (state your name), do hereby affirm that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of trustee of Kishwaukee College District #523. I will abide by the code of ethics, as contained in the Board Policy Manual and act in the best interests of the citizens of the district."

The oath or affirmation shall be administered by the secretary of the board, a notary public, or any other officer authorized to administer oaths under State law. The completed oath shall be filed with the secretary of the board and made part of the official records of the community college district.

No trustee may exercise the powers or perform the duties of office until the oath has been taken and properly filed.
