Board Trustee elections are conducted biannually in accordance with Sections 3-7 through 3-7.13 (as amended) of the *Illinois Public Community College Act*. Voting trustees are elected for staggered terms of six (6) years.

Each voting Trustee shall on the date of the Trustee's election be a citizen of the United States, of the age of 18 years or over, and a resident of the state of Illinois and District 523 for at least one (1) year preceding his/her election.

In accordance with 110 ILCS 805/3-7 a person who is a member of a common school board, upon election as a Trustee, will upon the expiration of the common school board term, not be eligible for election or appointment to a common school board during the term of office with the community college district board of trustees.

Board members may not be employees of the College or have financial interest in College business. (*Reference: 110 ILCS 805/3-48 and Board Policy 1.09 Conflict of Interest*).
