## **Getting started with PATH**



#### STEP 1

Decide which healthcare field is right for you. Staff and faculty at Kish are here to assist. Visit campus or contact advising@kish.edu to get started.

#### STEP 2

Apply to Kishwaukee College online. Once you have your student ID number, you can enroll in classes and pick your schedule for the term.

#### STEP 3

Apply for PATH grant funding through the website. The PATH grant application is available at www.kish.edu/pathgrant

#### STEP 4

Once notified of your PATH grant award, complete the process to accept funding for the semester. After acceptance, funding will be applied directly to your account.



### Additional Supports Available

As part of the PATH grant, students may receive funding beyond tuition to support their enrollment in an eligible healthcare program. This can include textbooks, materials, internet reimbursement, and mileage for travel expenses to clinical sites. Additional documentation is required for this support.
