THE PROGRAM

The transfer program in Accounting prepares students to enter a four-year college or university with business core courses completed. By completing the requirements for the Associate in Science degree at Kishwaukee College, students entering a four-year public university in Illinois will have fulfilled the General Education requirements for that institution and enter prepared to complete upper-level Accounting courses.

A complete listing of all Associate in Science degree requirements is available in the Kishwaukee College catalog. Students planning to transfer are recommended to check with the four-year institution to which they plan to transfer for course transferability and school requirements. Students are advised to meet with a faculty advisor/counselor to review credit transfers.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES
