#### Enrollment Report

An update was provided showing ECE program enrollments and graduates from 2015 through 2018

#### Program Updates and discussion

- Review of ECE curriculum changes
  - Committee members shared their concerns that the decision to eliminate the ECE AAS
    degree and some courses came too suddenly in spring 2018 and without adequate time to
    consider other alternatives
  - Committee members identified structural program issues that should be considered for future growth of the ECE program, including: the need for more evening and/or hybrid courses; the use of 4-C (Community Coordinated Child Care) location as alternate course site; the adjustment of some course caps to avoid blocking student registration; more recruitment from/coordination with DKHS and KEC dual-credit courses
  - There was discussion about suspending rather than eliminating the AAS degree for ECE
  - Dr. Kanter would initiate contact with other area CCs for course options for ECE students wishing to complete an AAS following completion of teach-out
- Spring advising Jud reported that her and Julie Oberheim (academic advisor) were working closely with current ECE students to track them toward completion of AAS if possible
- Marketing spring courses Similarly, email and phone outreach to all current ECE students to publicize spring 19 courses
- ECE staffing and scheduling Jud noted need for new instructors for ECE 281 and 223
