I. Program Update

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed without corrections. Current program enrollments were shared, identifying an increase in enrollment in fall 2022.

II. Curriculum and Student Outcomes

Committee shared that public speaking and communication skills continue to be essential in industry. Additional topics to explore include data analytics and experiential learning.

Committee agrees that continuing to include topics on Human Resource Management within courses and programs is beneficial to graduates. Committee will review course student learning outcomes as part of the spring 2023 advisory committee meeting.

III. Industry Update & Labor Market Discussion

Committee discussed the industry need for bookkeeping professionals and agrees with labor market analysis. Support of the College exploring a certificate program in bookkeeping was expressed.

IV. Work-Based Learning

The program continues to look for Marketing and Business internship partners with local businesses. Advisory committee partners do not have current opportunities available but will stay vigilant for opportunities within their networks.

Discussion led to ideas of e-mentoring programs that pair past graduates and business owners with current students. An e-mentor would provide support structure to students who are interested in developing connections with business.
