## I. Program Update

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed without corrections. Current program enrollments were shared, identifying an increase in enrollment in fall 2022.

Students enrolled in the fall 2022 Field Studies course visited a variety of local and regional locations including Klehm Arboretum & Botanic Garden, Nicholas Conservatory, Anderson Japanese Gardens, Midwest Groundcovers, Blumen Gardens, Pizzo, and Hinsdale Nursery. Kishwaukee College alumni and interns employed by these organizations provided tours to current students.

### II. Curriculum and Student Outcomes

Revised curriculum has been implemented, which reduced credit hours for all certificates. All certificate programs are able to be completed in one year by a full-time student.

## III. Industry Update & Labor Market Discussion

Committee discussed how businesses train employees. Committee states most students coming out of the Kishwaukee College program are more skilled than entry level labor.

One of the challenges in industry is finding applicants with required training and retaining them. Because of this, many employers have focused on employee retention strategies. Some organizations have had to rely on staffing agencies for labor needs.

## IV. Work-Based Learning

Committee is open to work-based learning programs and internships for horticulture students. Interview Day for spring internships will be held in person in early March 2023. An email will be sent out in January to save the dates for Interview Day and employee panel discussions.
