Update of Last Advisory Meeting Minutes and Opening Remarks

Previous meeting minutes deemed accurate by committee members

Spring 2021 Enrollment & Financial Information

- -College enrollment for spring 2021 semester is down -14.4% over spring 2020 semester
- -College Online/Hybrid credits up 212.7% over spring semester
- -Radiologic Technology department program credits even (-0.4% from spring 2020 to spring 2021)

Department Update

A. Class of 2020 & 2021

- Committee: Students at clinical sites are doing well and have no issues
- Trotto: Two part time openings on 1st and 2nd shifts, KC students have applied interviews are being held in the next few weeks
- Ciontea: Staffing between Kishwaukee and Valley West have been stable. No mass hiring expected in the future, but will communicate any openings to the current class
- Fox: Will set up the make-up schedule for modality rotations during summer 2021 at the clinical sites that the students could not complete

A. Vaccination Update from Clinical Sites

 Dunn: Staff/students are not required to get the vaccine, rates were in the 3-5% range last week but recently have increased to 8-9%. Inpatient admissions have been low 3-6 inpatients over the last several weeks

- Trotto: 23-25 patients admitted, last week 5-6 patients admitted. Rush Copley is not going back to restricting students/staff renewed focus to keep their Personal Protective Equipment on
- Miller: Vaccination is not mandated for their staff/students, trend in numbers going up is visible at their site

B. Facilities & Equipment

- -Suggestion to provide incoming students with a personal protective equipment list as part of their dress code requirements
- -Fox states: Accepting 12 new students, they will have goggles and face shields for those incoming students
- -Hamilton: Rush Copley will give all students face shields/masks

- B. 2021 Schedule and Changes
 - Site visit is scheduled at Rochelle Community Hospital and Northwestern Medicine Kish Health
 - JRCERT wants to Zoom with our clinical instructors, and the college will be sending out a help sheet with information, syllabus, and copies of Kish assessments for review for this virtual meeting
 - Faculty are working on-site visit qualifications and expectations from JRCERT
 - Annual electronic report due May 3rd and will be posted to the radiography website
 - No changes to 2021 assessment data

AART – New Clinical Competency Sheets

- A. Damask presented the AART new clinical competency sheet changes/updates:
 - Zygomatic arches were removed and replaced with sternoclavicular joints added to the elective list
 - Mobile Orthopedic exam wording was removed and replaced with mobile upper or lower extremity added
 - Pediatric upper and lower extremity was changed to pediatric upper or lower extremity
 - Geriatric upper and lower extremity was changed to geriatric upper or lower extremity
 - Geriatric hip or spine was added to the elective list
 - Simulations are allowed at the end of program were at 8 but changed to 10
 - These changes will start with our current 1st year students (not 2nd year students taking current exam)

Radiographer Educator Meeting

- A. Presentation regarding the William Callahan Zoom event in February 2021
 - 1. Topics covered
 - Reviews textbooks used, the amounts/costs, and what is used during the program
 - Synchronous and asynchronous courses and how important hands on learning labs are needed for radiography program
 - Other institutions expressed concerns for Zoom taught lessons, and have identified remote delivery as a cause for higher than average fail rates.
 - Students participated in a survey with Callaway
 - Follow-up meeting via Zoom on April 30, 2021
