Kishwaukee College is an accredited State of Illinois public community college that awards twoyear associate degrees. These degrees prepare students to transfer to a college or university to complete bachelor's degrees. The College is located in Malta, Illinois just six miles west of Northern Illinois University in DeKalb, Illinois and 70 miles west of Chicago. Kishwaukee College is authorized by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) to enroll non citizens.

Application Checklist

- Proof of English proficiency. Students need only submit proof of one of the following:
 - TOEFL score of 61 on the iBT
 - IELTS overall band score of 6.0
 - Completion of Level 109 at an ELS Language Center

*Applicants who are citizens of countries with English as the official language, or who have completed a college-level English composition course, are exempt from this requirement

- All official transcripts and academic credentials from prior schools attended. Transcripts from foreign countries must be evaluated by ECE or WES
- International student statement of finances completed by sponsor
- Original bank statement from sponsor reflecting an available bank balance equal to or greater than \$23,328. An additional \$4,200 is required for each dependent. Personal bank and sponsor letters should be signed or stamped by the sponsor bank official and cannot be older than ninety (90) days.

If already in the United States with a nonimmigrant visa the following items are also required:

- Copy of current I-20
- Copy of visa
- Copy of I-94 record
- Copy of I-901 SEVIS fee payment
