### ☐ STEP 3 — Complete Additional Documentation

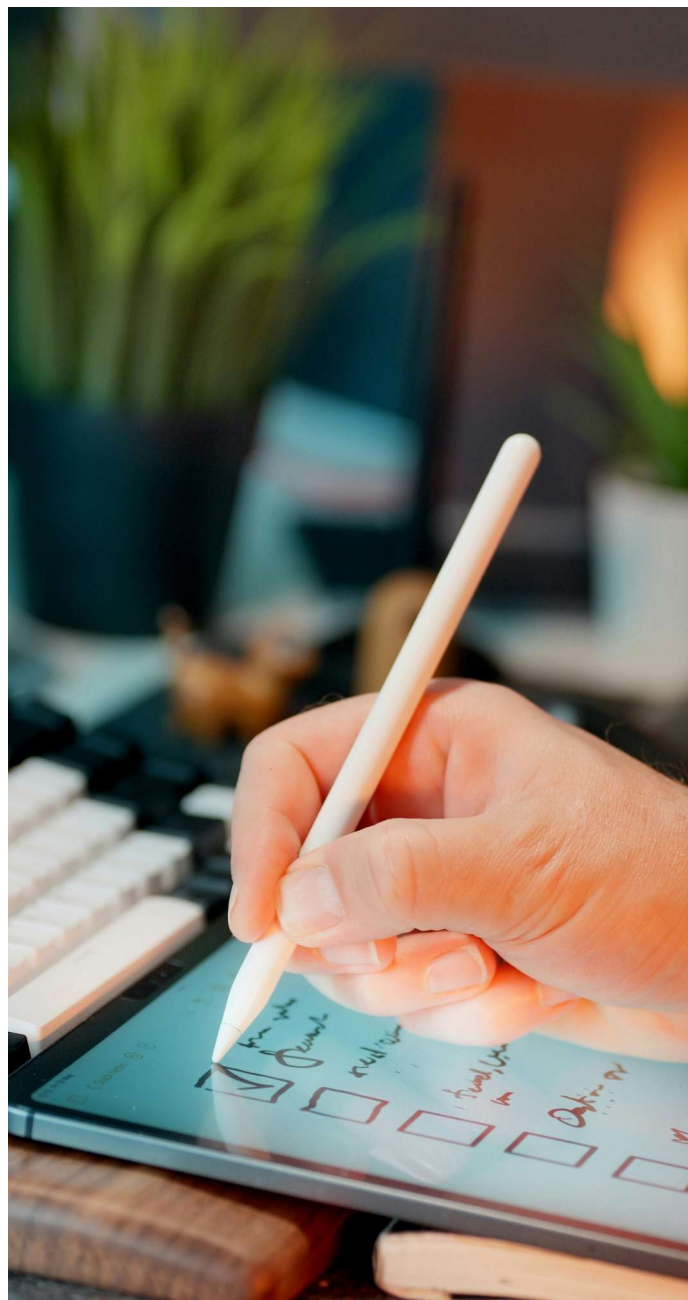
