Steps to Complete the FAFSA

STEP 1

Complete an FSA ID

- What you will need:
 - Valid email address
 - Valid telephone number
 - Social Security Number
- To complete the FSA ID first time students should visit www.fsaied.gov to create a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) which is required to complete the FAFSA.

STEP 2

Complete the FAFSA

- What you will need:
 - FSA ID for student and parent (if dependent)
 - Driver's License
 - Copy of 2019 Tax return for student and parent (if dependent)
 - Copy of 2019 W-2 information
 - Current financial statements
- Go to www.studentaid.gov select *Apply for Aid* and then *Complete the FAFSA form*.

STEP 3

Review Your SAR Report

- Your SAR will provide you will important information. On this it will provide you with your Expected Family Contribution or EFC which is used to determine your eligibility for Grants, Scholarships and Loans.

STEP 4

Complete Additional Documentation as Requested

- The Department of Education randomly selected FAFSA's for a process called verification. On average about 1 out of every 3 applications is selected. If you are selected you may be asked to provide supporting documentation, such as, a Tax Return Transcript, W-2 information, Verification of Household size and other information as needed.
- In addition to verification there can also be additional documentation requested depending on how you complete your FAFSA.
