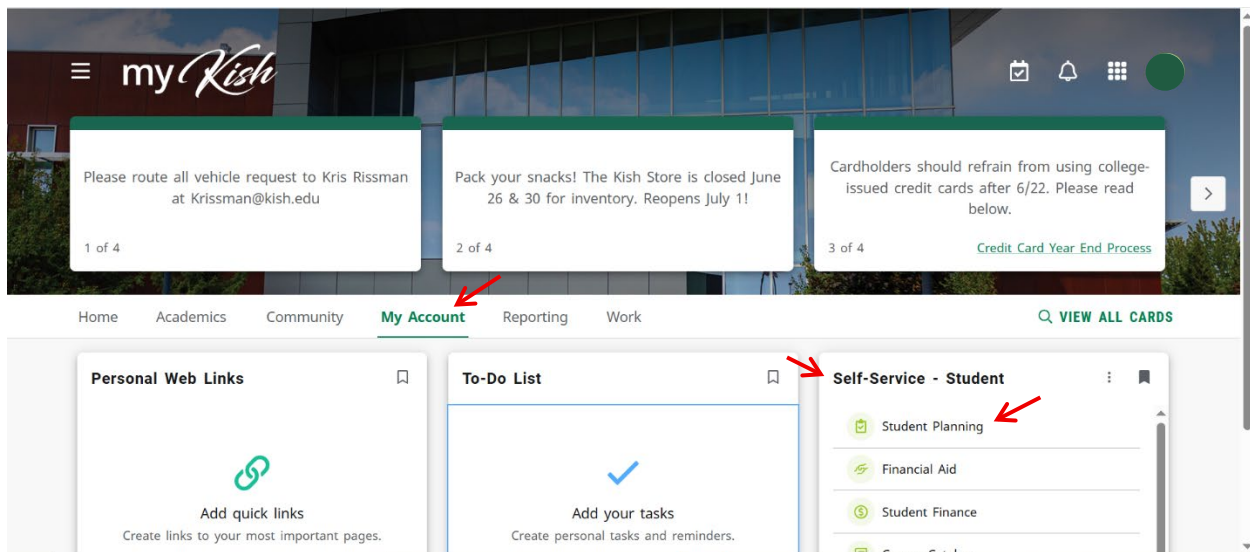


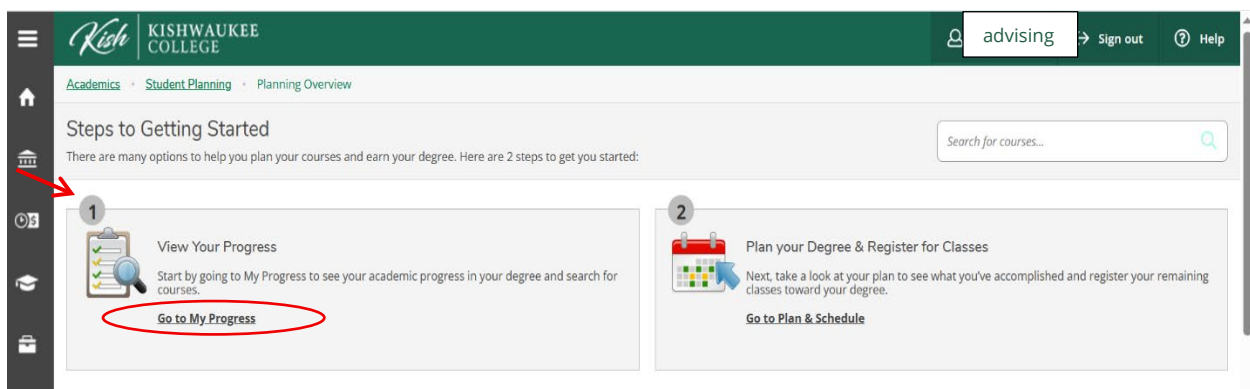


View Academic Progress




