## Transfer Agreement Summary

<b>Agreement type</b>	Guaranteed Admission Agreement
<b>Summary and Benefits of the Program</b>	<p>This Guaranteed Admissions Agreement offers Kishwaukee College students to Northern Illinois University (NIU) to complete their Bachelor's Degrees. Students must meet all of the requirements outlined in the Agreement to guarantee their admissions to NIU.</p>
<b>Academic Requirements</b>	<p>Students must have graduated from high school (as evidence by a high school diploma or GED), completed a minimum of 24 transferable semester credit hours &amp; maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale on all transferrable course work taken at Kish and all colleges/universities attended prior to admission to the program.</p> <p>Students are expected to enroll and complete general education and coursework required for admission into NIU's degree program. Courses numbered lower than 100 level and courses not deemed transferable are not included in this agreement.</p> <p>Students on a non-immigrant visa must have completed both ENG 103 and ENG 104 grades C or higher to meet the English proficiency requirements of NIU. Students will not need to submit separate proof of English proficiency at the time of application.</p>
<b>Admission Requirements and Benefits</b>	<p>Students must provide NIU with a written authorization to disclose their education records.</p> <p>Students must be in good standing with Kishwaukee College at the time of transfer.</p> <p>Students whose transferable GPA is a 3.20 on a 4.0 scale will have guaranteed admission to the University's Honors Program at NIU. (Additional application materials are required to be admitted into the honors program.)</p> <p>During the program, NIU will provide advisement to students to discuss academic requirements and transfer credit policies.</p> <p>Students are eligible to transfer into more than 56 undergraduate degree programs at NIU.</p> <p>Students may qualify for NIU scholarships.</p>

## Reverse Transfer Agreement Summary

<b>Agreement type</b>	Reverse Transfer
<b>Summary and Benefits of the Program</b>	Students enrolled at NIU who previously attended KC or are currently enrolled at KC and have completed at least 37 credit hours at Kishwaukee College may be eligible for reverse credit toward an Associate degree at Kishwaukee College.

## Transfer Agreement Summary

<b>Agreement type</b>	BSN Completion Program
<b>Summary and Benefits of the Program</b>	This articulation agreement allows Kishwaukee College Students who completed an Associate Degree in Nursing will be admitted to the baccalaureate RN-B. Nursing Degree-Completion Program at NIU, provided that they meet the requirements stated in the Transfer Guide for the RN-BS program.

<b>Transfer Programs</b>	BS in Technology with an emphasis in Applied Manufacturing Technology
<b>Kishwaukee College Program</b>	AAS degree
<b>Agreement type</b>	3+1 Articulation Agreement
<b>Summary and Benefits of the Program</b>	Students will be allowed to transfer 59 credit hours + 31 Bachelor's Foundation Courses at Kishwaukee College and take their remaining 30 credit hours online from NIU.

## Transfer Agreement Summary

<b>Agreement type</b>	Memorandum of Understanding
<b>Summary and Benefits of the Program</b>	This agreement is to develop a coordinated curricular pathway to ensure the maximum number of credit hours for transfer between Kish and NIU for an Off-Campus AAS to Bachelor's Degree-Completion Program. This pathway will facilitate efficient transitions for students seeking to complete an online Bachelor of Science in Technology, with an emphasis in Applied Manufacturing Technology.
<b>Terms of the agreement</b>	<p>Students with an approved AAS degree who are admitted to the NIU's program are understood to have earned at least 59 hours of credit from the Community College that can be applied toward the BS degree.</p> <p>Admitted students will need to complete all NIU general education requirements as specified by the agreement.</p> <p>NIU will provide a rotation of upper-division courses to assist ensure a seamless transfer.</p> <p>Students will be able to begin taking NIU courses at any time following formal admission as long as they have completed the pertinent course prerequisites.</p>
<b>Admission Requirements</b>	Admission to the program requires that applicants be admitted to NIU as a regular degree-seeking student and have completed an approved AAS degree in a specific technology discipline. All other prevailing requirements governing the transfer of students between NIU and Kish will hold for this agreement.
