Requirements	<p>To become a part of the KC-RU Collaboration, a student must meet the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. have earned a minimum of 24 transferrable credits or completed an AAS in Automotive Technology, AAS in Marketing & Management, or AAS in Technology and Manufacturing at KC;2. have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale);3. provide official transcripts;4. complete the BSMS application;5. pay the current application fee. <p>To remain a part of the KC-RU Collaboration and receive a BSMS, a student must meet the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. complete the program requirements as outlined in the applicable catalog;2. maintain cumulative grade point averages of at least a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale every semester;3. complete all 60 credits from a four-year institution and 30 of the last 36 credits from RU.
