Summary Student Admissions Eligibility	 The purpose of the Business Administration Pathway Program is for students to be able to obtain a bachelor degree by attending KC and then attending SIUE. Upon completion of the curricula requirements agreed upon by both parties, students will qualify for an Associate of Science Degree from KC and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with the appropriate specialization from SIUE. Student Admissions Eligibility Students are required to submit a Pathway Application for Admission to SIUE. Students are encouraged to submit the application as soon as they have identified an interest in the Business Administration Pathway Program. Students are admissible to SIUE after having completed a minimum of30 semester hours at KC with a minimum cumulative OPA of 2.0. Although a student will be admitted to SIUE, minimum admission standards must be met for acceptance into the School of Business. These standards are outlined in the curriculum attached to this Agreement. The SIUE catalog will be in effect from the time of provisional admission throughout continuous enrollment and timely completion of degree requirements. Students failing to complete requirements. Prior to the student's anticipated entry term, SIUE will review the student's academic progress to ensure admission requirements to the University and the SIUE School of Business have been satisfied. Students who are satisfactorily completing the KC part
	 School of Business have been satisfied. Students who are satisfactorily completing the KC part of the agreed upon curriculum, and minimum admission standards for the School of Business, attached to the Agreement
	 will be admitted directly to their intended major in SIUE following formal admission to SIUE.
Academic Standing & Retention	Once admitted to SIUE, students will be subjected to standard retention requirements applied to all SIUE students. Students

	must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to remain in good academic standing with the University. However, students must maintain a GPA of 2.25 to remain in the School of Business. Upon matriculation, students must adhere to the SIUE and the School of Business program of study retention standards.

SCHOOL OF BUSINESS APPLICATION

Preferred March 1: Students seeking admission to the School of Business for the following summer or fall term. Preferred October 1: Students seeking admission to the School of Business for the following spring term. Applications are reviewed every two weeks; students are notified within 3-4 weeks after review. Application are available 1 month prior to the deadline on the School of Business website: https://www.siue.edu/business/apply/

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

For summer applicants, all of the following 7 *prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better by the end of the preceding spring semester.

For fall applicants, all of the following 7 *prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better by the end of the preceding summer semester.

For spring applicants, all of the following 7 *prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better by the end of the preceding fall semester.

Prerequisite courses: ENG 103, ENG 104, COM 100, CIS 101, ECO 260, ECO 261, MAT 150. ACC 121 and MAT 211 are required but are no longer prerequisites. MAT 211 will be waived for any student that has completed MATH 229 or higher with a grade of "C" or better. Students who are eligible to enroll in, or do complete, MAT 211, MAT 220 or MAT 229 will not need to take MAT 150. Students should be encouraged to complete, ACC 121, MAT 211, and MAT 220.

Students must have a 2.25 GPA to apply. The GPA is determined by all college level coursework taken at all higher education institutions. Our intention is to admit students who demonstrate the greatest likelihood of success. Decisions are based primarily on student performance in collegiate-level work as expressed in the grade point averages and the required essay. Due to the competitive nature of the admission process, not all students who apply are admitted.
