Summary of requirements	<p>Kishwaukee College students must complete a specific set of courses in order to be admitted to the College of Engineering at UIUC.</p> <p>Kishwaukee College students must maintain a combined 3.3 GPA in the specific set of courses; and in each of these required courses they must earn at least a grade of “B”.</p> <p>Kishwaukee College students must complete all requirements within 3 years of the date of initial Kishwaukee College enrollment in order to be eligible for the guarantee admission.</p>

The agreement includes the following ACES majors: Agricultural and Consumer Economics; Agricultural Leadership, Education, and Communications; Animal Sciences; Computer Science and Crop Sciences; Crop Sciences; Food Science and Human Nutrition; Human Development and Family Studies; Natural Resources and Environmental Sciences; and Technical Systems Management.
