(Additional general education credits may be needed to fulfill some programs requirements.</p> <p>Students from Kishwaukee College will be granted admission to a baccalaureate Degree program at the University of Phoenix on academic requirements as a result of having earned an associate degree and upon further satisfaction of all other conditions for admission as stated in the University of Phoenix's catalog.</p> <p>If a student is enrolled in the Bachelor of Science in Management program, the associate degree focus will be listed as an area of emphasis on the baccalaureate transcript and University of Phoenix diploma.</p> <p>Kishwaukee College students who are within 12 months of completion of their associate degree, may pre-apply to the University of Phoenix baccalaureate program and will be granted access to the University of Phoenix proficiency assessment system and University Library Online Collection.</p> <p>University of Phoenix will provide Kishwaukee College students with transfer support materials.</p> <p>University of Phoenix campus will provide onsite or online counseling services.</p>
