Benefits of the Program	<p>Kishwaukee College students do not have to relocate to WIU to earn their BA.</p> <p>Individuals who earned a degree at Kishwaukee College who wish to transfer to WIU's BA in General Studies (BGS) Degree Program may be admitted to the degree program as long as the minimum required admissions standards have been achieved.</p>

Summary and Benefits	<p>This agreement is concern with requirements for graduation designation from the Centennial Honors College upon completion of a degree at WIU.</p> <p>Honors students at Kishwaukee College who have completed 12 credit hours of honors coursework, with a grade of 'B' or better in each of the honors courses, and maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA or higher, have a special designation placed on their transcript, and are recognized at commencement.</p>
